In honour of Dr. George Mathew on the occasion of his retirement after thirty four years of dedicated service to Forest Entomology

Dr. George Mathew was heading the Forest Health Division of the Kerala Forest Research Institute when he retired in October 2011. He received his master's degree in Zoology (Entomology) from St. John's College, Agra in 1974 followed by a doctoral degree in Zoology from the University of Calicut in 1980.
